ABOUT THE ROLE

The Chief Operations Officer is responsible for the successful operation of the organisation's seven state and territory branches. The successful applicant will oversee a team of around 30 volunteers, including seven direct reports, to organise and deliver a range of events and projects across Australia, and create and maintain partnerships with key stakeholders. The Chief Operations Officer will be a key member of the Extended Leadership Team and will work closely alongside other National Directors and Branch Directors.
